

## 2018 NHRP Stalling Information

Each contestant entering timed events will be allowed ONE STALL PER EVENT they are competing in at the trials. **ROUGH STOCK** Contestants, **Shooting Sports** Contestants or Contestants who have not qualified in an event (Student/Officer Candidates) will NOT be issued stalls unless they qualify in another timed event or wish to pay the price for a "extra stall". Extra stalls will be issued on a first come, first served basis only after registered contestant horses are stalled. Any available extra stalls will be \$245. Location of these stalls is not guaranteed.

### CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

- Horse check in will be open 24 hours beginning at 12:00 noon on Thursday, June 21<sup>st</sup> until 7:00am, Sunday June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018. **All HORSES AND CAMPERS MUST BE CHECKED IN BY 6:00PM SUNDAY, JUNE 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018. CONTESTANTS MUST BE CHECKED IN BY 7:00AM ON SUNDAY.**
- **In the event of a late arrival, contact the Media Office at 805-253-6628**
- App(NT)horse(s) of the South Dakota State Fairgrounds MUST BE CHECKED IN THROUGH HORSE CHECK-IN AND BE STALLED ON GROUNDS.
- Have all horse papers available at check in, including Coggins (within 12 months of the event), and Health Inspection (within 30 days of the event) and Brand Inspection (if you are from a Brand State). It is important that you make copies for yourself before you leave home.
- If you are leasing a horse, the contestant is responsible for informing the horse owner of the required checks in paperwork. A leased horse will not be checked in without the above paperwork. **LEASED HORSES MUST ALSO BE STALLED ON GROUNDS.**
- **ONLY STALLS WILL BE STALLED IN STALLS RESERVED FOR SADDLE HORSES.**
- Horses may not be ridden or walked in the Computer, parking lots, the medical area, the recreation area, the trade show area, pedestrian areas OR IN ANY STALLING BARN.
- **ALL HOOFED ANIMALS BROUGHT ON THE GROUNDS MUST BE IN A STALL ON THE GROUNDS- THIS INCLUDES GOATS.** Goats brought on grounds MUST have valid health inspection papers.

### DURING THE EVENT

- PLEASE PARK HORSE TRAILERS IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS. Parking staff will help you find the appropriate place.
- Stalls will be monitored at all times by the event staff.
- The following barn rules will be enforced for any barn on grounds:
  - **Barn Rules**
    - **Do not wash animals or tack in any barns. Water hoses in any barns is prohibited! Please use wash racks outside the barns**
    - **DO NOT leave hoses running or flowing anywhere! Water will pool in the lowest point and can flow "downstream" stalls!**
    - **Heaters and fires are prohibited in the barns**
    - **NO GOLF CARTS IN THE BARN!**
    - **Signs in barns are prohibited unless approved by NHRP Personnel.**
    - **Keep Stalls Clean and use Designated manure pit at the end of each barn**

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
