Optional NHSFR Jackpot Guidelines

THIS IS FOR THE JACKPOT IN THE MAIN COMPETITION ARENAS ONLY, NOT THE PRACTICE AND JACKPOT ARENAS ON GROUNDS THROUGHOUT THE WEEK. YOU ENTER THOSE JACKPOTS ON GROUNDS AT THE ARENA.

If contestant chooses to enter the <u>competition jackpot</u>, he/she will enter jackpot on the Contestant Entry Form provided in Contestant Packet. Fees will be paid to the state/province association. Contestant does not have to jackpot any or all events entered. He/she may choose to jackpot any or all events entered. All contestants (except Canada, Australia & Mexico) entering the jackpot will be required to fill out and submit a W-9 form providing their social security number. The form is to be turned in with your entry.

FAILURE TO SUBMIT THE W-9 WITH YOUR ENTRY WILL DELAY PROCESSING YOUR CHECK!

If team ropers wish to enter the jackpot, then <u>both partners</u> must enter and the fee would be double the amount or \$300 per team - (\$150 per contestant).

No jackpotting in the Queen Contest or Shooting Competition events.

State/Province Secretary will fill out jackpot summary sheet and mail in with one check made payable to the NHSRA with NHSFR entries. Jackpot contestants will be entered in NHSFR Computer Program as they are entered in the NHSFR. The computer program will calculate results along with the placing/points and the jackpot results will be printed on the same report as the official results and posted.

Jackpot fee: \$150 per event – breakdown:

\$30 office fee to NHSRA

\$30 to the first go

\$30 to the second go

\$30 to the short go

\$30 to the average

All jackpot fees are non-refundable, non-transferable. Any contestant drawing out for any reason forfeits the jackpot fee.

Jackpot payout for each go-round and average:

6 Places

1 st Place – 29%	2 nd Place – 24%	3 rd Place – 19%
4 th Place – 14%	5 th Place – 9%	6 th Place – 5%

Only contestants entering the jackpot are eligible for payout. For example, if the top placing jackpot contestant is officially third place in the round, he/she wins first place jackpot money and etc. down to the top 6 finishers that entered the jackpot.

Contestants winning money will be required to sign for their check. First-go and Second-go checks will be available in the Rodeo Office. Short-Go and Average checks will be mailed.

Deadline for entering the jackpot is the same as the official NHSFR entry. Roll ups will be allowed to enter the jackpot as long as the jackpot fee is received with the roll up entry.
