RE: 2020 - 2021 State/Provincial Association Dues

This is a reminder to all State/Province members of the NHSRA and Junior High that pursuant to the 2020-2022 NHSRA Rulebook:

Page 4, Paragraph 6(a):

The annual dues from the member State/Province Associations shall be set by the Board of National Directors payable in advance and postmarked on or before September 1 of each year.

The annual NHSRA State/Province Association dues for the 2020-2021 year are \$450 per state/province as per board approval.

The annual NHSRA Junior High State/Province Association dues for the 2020-2021 year are \$225 per state/province as per board approval.

Page 5, Paragraph 6(b):

All State/Province Associations shall submit their dues, a list of all adult directors, and student officers of the State/Province Association, and the name of their queen chairman, to the National Office by September 1.

Page 5, Paragraph 7:

Failure to pay dues and registration:

If the State/Province Association dues are not postmarked by September 1, of each year, no contestant from said State/Province shall be qualified to participate in the National High School Finals Rodeo for said year until dues with penalties are paid. A \$50 per day late fee will be charged to the State/Province Association for each day the State/Province dues are late. Late will be defined as postmarked anytime after September 1.

PLEASE NOTE: When submitting your list of all adult and student directors and student officers, please include addresses, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses. This is very important as we communicate with these individuals at various times throughout the year. We also need the queen coordinator information at this time.

_____ OPTION 1: Cutting Horse Event will be offered for each approved qualifying, practice and/or state/province or district rodeo. Cutting may be held in conjunction with the rodeo or held at a different time and location for each rodeo. Cutting must be offered the same number of times as all the other events, such as pole bending, bull riding, etc. If OPTION 1 is used, all points earned throughout the year and at the state/provincial finals will be applied toward the All Around.

_____ OPTION 2: Cutting Horse Event must be offered a minimum three (3) times within each district and/or state/province and their finals. Only the points earned at the finals will count toward the All Around. Points earned at the qualifying events and the state/provincial finals will be used for the year end Cutting Champion.
