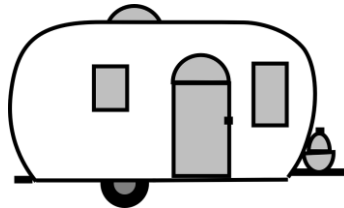




## 2022 NJHFR CAMPSITE INFORMATION



The campsites in Perry, GA are mostly flat. There are some spaces on grass and some on concrete. The sites are all considered “full service.” If there is not a sewer hookup, the fairgrounds have made arrangements for everyone to be pumped out every couple of days. The sites are all \$350 for the event

Reservations for camping will be made through the National Office and campsites will be assigned on a state/provincial area block. We will make every attempt to keep everyone camped with their state, however, if others from your state are inconsiderate as they arrive, we may have to camp you in another area. **We HIGHLY recommend that someone from your state coordinates parking for your designated area so that everyone can be camped together.**

***Electric service is 30 amp and some 50 amp. You are not guaranteed a 50-amp site, so please make provisions to prepare for this. This may mean you will need adapters.***

Extended families will be invited to camp as well, however their reservation **MUST** be received with the rest of the state or provincial reservations (including full payment to the state secretary) by the paperwork deadline. We cannot accept reservations beyond that time and still have the time to get everyone assigned.

State and Provincial secretaries should collect payment from all campers and remit one check from your state or province to the NHSRA. **There will be no refunds issued after June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022! If a refund is approved, it will be remitted directly to the State Secretary who will disperse funds accordingly in August 2022.** NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR CAMP SITES UNLESS THERE IS A CLERICAL ERROR OR IF REFUND REQUEST IS RECEIVED BEFORE JUNE 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022.
