CAM-PLEX FACILITY RULES**

Gillette, Wyoming

DOGS

Dogs are not allowed in any buildings, except for marked service animals as required per the Americans with Disability Act. Dogs can be on grounds if on a leash, and owners must promptly clean up after their pets.

NOISE

Please be considerate of your neighbors when outside.

SMOKING

All buildings, outdoor facilities, and stalls are smoke and vape free environments.

TRASH

Please dispose of all trash into a dumpster or trash can provided around CAM-PLEX grounds.

CAMPFIRES

Open flame campfires, firepits, and cookers are NOT allowed in any of the camping areas.

FIREWORKS

Fireworks and pyrotechnics are strictly prohibited on grounds without a permit and CAM-PLEX approval.

GRANDSTANDS

Blocking sections of the grandstands is not permitted. All seating is first come/first serve. Blue seats are reserved for VIP/Event Sponsors. Any blankets, chairs, banners, etc. left in the grandstands will be removed and taken to the lost & found.

PARKING

Park all vehicles in designated parking spots and off campground roads. Please abide by all signage to allow adequate fire lanes.

DAMAGES

Any alterations/damages to campsites or stalls will result in a damage fee.

OTHER

The following are not allowed inside any CAM-PLEX buildings: bicycles, skateboards, candles, confetti, glass drinking containers, grills and smokers, illegal substances, kettle corn vending, or propane bottles larger than one pound.
