

RV and General Policies for the Georgia National Fairgrounds & Agricenter

*****SECURITY CAMERAS ARE IN USE*****

1. "Full hookups" include water/electricity. Some sites include sewage. A dump station is located east of the Covered Horse Arena. (If you are assigned to a site without a sewage hookup, you will be pumped out on a regular basis during the week at no charge to you.)
2. **GENERATORS ARE PROHIBITED.** Absolutely **NO TENT CAMPING.**
3. GNFA reserves right to refuse occupancy.
4. **Leash Law Enforced:** Pets allowed and must be on a maximum 6' leash. Pets must be under the control of owner at all times. *Please report loose pets!* Pet owners who cannot control their pets will be asked to leave. Bathing pets in restrooms or showers is prohibited.
5. One (1) additional vehicle maximum is allowed with RV in designated spot. Guest or additional vehicles must park in designated areas.
6. A valid drivers license is required to operate motorized vehicles. (Passenger cars, trucks, 4 wheelers, golf carts, scooters etc.) Please operate vehicles on designated roadways. Absolutely no motor vehicles allowed in the barns or on the grass. 4 wheelers, golf carts, scooters ,etc. may not be permitted for particular events as determined by show personnel and GNFA Security. Reckless use of motor vehicles will result in suspension from the grounds.
7. Roller blades, skateboards, roller skates, and push scooters are prohibited.
8. Ground fires are prohibited. Any outdoor grill cooking should be done on a self-contained BBQ grill.
9. Bicycles are prohibited in barns and the surrounding loading zones. Parents are responsible for kids riding bicycles during the week.
10. Please obey all stop signs and speed limits. The speed limit is 15 m.p.h.
11. Bows & arrows, explosives, fireworks, slingshots, fishing spears, or any device that discharges projectiles by any means is prohibited.
12. Fishing in the lakes is reserved for our registered youth programs only.
13. Consumption or use of alcoholic beverages or intoxicants is unlawful in any public-use area without proper permits.
14. Vehicles parked in fire lanes, loading zones, RV spaces, handicapped parking, or outside of designated parking areas without proper permits, will be towed at owners expense.
