Optional NJHFR Jackpot Guidelines

THIS IS FOR THE JACKPOT IN THE MAIN COMPETITION ARENAS ONLY, NOT THE PRACTICE AND JACKPOT ARENAS ON GROUNDS THROUGHOUT THE WEEK.

YOU ENTER THOSE JACKPOTS ON GROUNDS AT THE JACKPOT ARENA

Contestants who choose to enter the competition jackpot, will enter the jackpot on the Contestant Entry Form provided in Contestant Packet. Fees will be paid to the state/province association. Contestant may choose to enter the jackpot for any/all events he/she qualified in.

All contestants (except Canada, Australia New Zealand & Mexico) entering the jackpot will be required to fill out and submit a W-9 form providing their social security number. The form is to be turned in with your entry.

YOU MUST SUBMIT W9 WITH CONTESTANT NAME TO BE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER OPTIONAL JACKPOT OR RECEIVE A JACKPOT CHECK. W9's MUST BE FILLED OUT WITH THE CONTESTANTS' INFORMATION!

If team ropers/ ribbon ropers wish to enter the jackpot, then both partners must enter and the fee would be double the amount or \$200 per team - (\$100 per contestant).

No jackpotting in the Shooting Competition.

Jackpot contestants will be entered in NJHFR Computer Program as they are entered in the NJHFR. The computer program will calculate results along with the placing/points and the jackpot results will be printed on the same report as the official results and posted on the Official Posting Board.

All jackpot fees are non-refundable, non-transferable.

Any contestant drawing out for any reason forfeits the jackpot fee.

Jackpot fee: \$100 per event – breakdown:

\$20 office fee to NHSRA

\$20 to the first go

\$20 to the second go

Jackpot payout for each go-round and average:

6 Places

1st Place – 29% 2nd Place – 24%

3rd Place – 19% 4th Place – 14%

5th Place- 9% 6th Place – 5%

\$20 to the short go

\$20 to the average

Only contestants entering the jackpot are eligible for payout.

First-go and Second-go checks will be available in the Rodeo Office.

Short-Go and Average checks will be mailed.

Deadline for entering the jackpot is the same as the official NJHFR entry.

Roll ups will be allowed to enter the jackpot as long as the jackpot fee is received with the roll up entry.
