**Dance Dress Code:** Contestants are required to wear contestant numbers at Contestant Dances - **FELT BACK NUMBERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE WORN AT THE DANCES.** Long pants, or pants that are at least knee length must be worn – NO SHORTS. Shirts do not have to be tucked in provided no skin is showing. NO TANK TOPS, MID-DRIFT OR HALTER TOPS ALLOWED. Footwear is required and shoes may be open toed. **Conduct:** Dancing must be appropriate and clean. Foul language and insubordination to directors and chaperones is grounds for rodeo disqualification. Only one guest per contestant and you are responsible for your guest. You **MUST** purchase your "Dance Guest" back number in the Rodeo Office for \$10 if you plan to bring a guest to the dances. It is your responsibility to keep track of this number and your guest. You can be disqualified for conduct of your guest. Guests are required to follow dress code and conduct rules. Your dance guest must pay \$2 each time they plan to attend the dances.
