lowa weather in the summer can be unpredictable from excessive humidity to drought to rain. Here's some tips to hopefully make things easier.

- Bring fans from home if you can stores sell out quickly in the area around the fairgrounds during the summer months
 - Some barns don't have the best airflow
- Start horses on electrolytes prior to arriving so it's not new when they arrive
- Be smart about using furosemide (Lasix) on horses in humid weather as they can get dehydrated very easily on that medication in high humidity
