



Explanation of the NJHFR Draw

This event consists of two (2) long go-rounds and one (1) short go-round. Points are awarded to the top 20 in each event in each go-round **and** the average.

Each contestant competes in his/her event at least twice – once in each of the first two long go-rounds. The top 20 in each event following the completion of the first two go-rounds qualify for the short go-round.

AM Performances are at 9AM

PM Performances are at 7PM

There are a total of 13 performances at the NJHFR, starting on Sunday at 7 p.m. and then one at 9 a.m. and one at 7 p.m. each day, with **the short go-round performance on Saturday evening at 7 p.m.**

The first go-round includes performances on Sunday PM, Monday AM and PM, Tuesday AM and PM and Wednesday AM; Second go-round includes performances Wednesday PM, Thursday AM and PM, Friday AM and PM and Saturday AM; short go-round on Saturday PM.

Position draw is done by computerized random selection and is done for the first go-round; positions for the second go-round are in reverse order from the first go-round.

Example: If you draw up Sunday evening in the first go, your second go-round will be Saturday morning. The same holds true for the exact position within each event. Example: If you draw up first in your event in the first go, you will be last in your event in the second go. Thereby, each contestant competes in one morning performance and one evening performance in their respective event.

Sunday evening – Saturday morning
Monday morning- Friday evening
Monday evening – Friday morning
Tuesday Morning – Thursday Night
Tuesday Night – Thursday Morning
Wednesday Morning – Wednesday Night

For the short go in all events except barrel racing and pole bending, the draw will be worked from the last qualifying position down to the first qualifying position. So, if you are leading your event going into the short go, you will compete last in your event in the short go. Positions for the short go in pole bending and barrel racing are drawn at random.

Explanation of Stock Draws

Bull Riding, Bareback Steer Riding and Saddle Bronc Steer Riding draws are done for the entire first go-round and posted Sunday afternoon. The entire second go-round is drawn and posted following the Wednesday morning performance. The short go-round is drawn and posted Saturday after the last performance of the 2nd go.

Timed Event Draws are done and posted **no earlier than 1 hour** prior to each performance.
