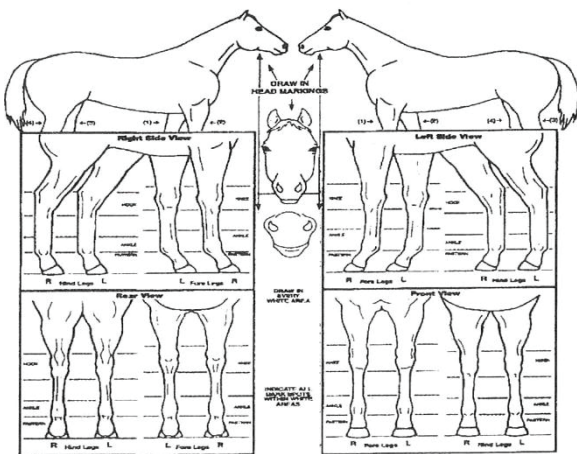

HORSE & GOAT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR NEBRASKA

Horses & Goats: Long before you travel, check that the Nebraska Entry Requirements are fulfilled.

1. CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) is needed for both horses & goats.

- **Horses:** CVI must include Coggins test which may be on the SAME document for horses.
- **Goats:** CVI must include Scrapies identification and may need pre-entry import certificate.

Have the licensed veterinarian issuing your CVI read the following:

NEBRASKA HEALTH REGULATIONS: Original Health Certificates (CVIs) must be presented along with other records for every horse & goat during NHSFR Lincoln Stalling Check-In and will be returned to you.

- Consignee of CVI must be National High School Finals Rodeo Committee, Lincoln, Nebraska.
- All horses and goats must be accompanied by a proper and current CVI issued by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of the opening date of the rodeo which is July 19, 2026 (no earlier than June 18, 2026).
- The CVI must certify that said animals are free from contagious disease and state the number, description, sex and ages of the horse(s) and goat(s).
- All horses must show proof that each horse has had a negative Coggins test conducted within 12 months of the July 19, 2026 opening date of the NHSFR. The date of the Coggins test and the name and address of the laboratory conducting the Coggins test shall be recorded on the CVI.
- All goats may require a pre-entry import permit prior to entry into Nebraska. Import Permits can be obtained by calling (402) 471-2351 or accessing the Nebraska Department of Agriculture website: <https://nda.nebraska.gov/animal/imports/import-requirements.html> and enter your origin point.
- If you are from a state that requires re-entry papers, PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND VETERINARIANS TO SEE WHAT PAPERS YOU WILL NEED FOR RE-ENTRY. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR OWN RE-ENTRY PAPERS AND REQUIREMENTS

2. The animal presented at check-in and the Horse or Goat Scrapies Identification Paper information should match. *Bring no less than three completed copies with you to Stalling Check-in.*

Completely fill out Horse Identification Paper: (Including owner and contestant's name)

1. Draw markings on chart on reverse side of this form.
2. State name, sex, breed, tattoo, brands color etc.

3. Make & bring the original and no less than three copies of the following documents: Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, Coggins test (for horses) & Horse or Goat Scrapies Identification Paper. DO NOT GIVE ANY OF THESE DOCUMENTS TO YOUR STATE SECRETARY.

- Original documents to accompany your horse & goat at all times in the truck or trailer while in route.
- These will be verified at Stalling Check-in when the horse and goat enters Sandhills Global Event Center. HORSE OR GOAT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS WITHOUT THESE DOCUMENTS ACCOMPANYING THE ANIMAL. ORIGINAL FORMS MUST BE PRESENTED AT CHECK IN AS NEBRASKA LAW DOES NOT ALLOW FOR COPIES TO BE PRESENTED.
- One set of copied documents should be kept separately in a safe place with you (personal luggage) to make additional copies if needed.
- Enough extra copies of the documents should be made to turn in at check points, weigh stations, etc. as needed while in route to comply with interstate health certificate (CVI) requirements while reserving the original and two copies for your check-in at Sandhills Global Event Center.

QUARANTINE: All horses and goats will be inspected upon arrival at the rodeo grounds; any abnormal findings on an animal will result in quarantine until release by the veterinarian in charge.

VACCINATIONS: It is prudent that horses and goats are updated on their annual vaccinations, including a West Nile Virus vaccine.

4. Check-in inspection: When arriving at Sandhills Global Event Center in Lincoln, Nebraska you will be subject to all Inspection Laws of the State of Nebraska (no brand inspection required for horses in eastern Nebraska). There will be no check-out inspection.
