



STALLING & HORSES/GOATS CHECK-IN

STALL POLICIES:

Each contestant entering the timed events or the queen contest will be allowed only one stall per event. Steer wrestlers and cutters will be allowed two stalls each. NO STALLS will be allowed for tack.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME:

- See back of Horse Identification Paper for Nebraska health paperwork needed to check-in each horse and goat that will be on grounds. Paperwork must be signed by a veterinarian and completely filled out before you enter the grounds with your horses & goats. Reference contestant's name and state/province/country team on **ALL** paperwork.
- Leased horses must have the same current paperwork.
- Brand inspections are not required by Nebraska State Law.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES IN LINCOLN:

- Contestant check-in will begin at 12pm (noon) on Thursday, July 16th and will operate 24 hours a day until 7am Sunday, July 19th. No early or late contestant check-in allowed without prior NHSRA main office staff written approval.
- Horse & Goat check-in also starts at 12pm (noon) on Thursday, July 16th and continues after contestant check-in closes 6pm Sunday July 19th. All horses & goats, including leased horses, **MUST** be checked in by 6pm Sunday, July 19th.
- All horses and goats entering Sandhills Global Event Center grounds must go through Stall Check-in starting at Gate 2 on Havelock Avenue (gate closest to 84th Street on south side of Havelock Ave).
- Studs will be stalled in the EquineMarket Pavilion.
- During the check-in procedure (located in Lot A), contestants will need to unload their horses, take their paperwork and lead their horses to the check-in area and then on to their assigned stall.
- Wristbands available for purchase on Friday & Saturday during check-in. (Limited hours)
- There will be trailer clean-out available in Lot E as you check into your campsite & get golf cart.

HORSE (& GOAT) RULES & SERVICES ON GROUNDS:

- Horses are only allowed in the stall and arena areas and there will be a designated path between the stalling area and the main outdoor performance arenas.
- No horses are permitted in the campgrounds, in parking lots/driveways, on the adjacent hiking/biking trail or anywhere outside of the arena and stalling areas.
- Warm-up spaces and times will be posted upon your arrival.
- Please use the wash racks. For indoor stalls they are located in EquineMarket Pavilion. For outdoor stalls they are between EquineMarket Pavilion & LivestockMarket Pavilion.
- Do not tie horses up to any water faucets, fences, signs, buildings (other than wash rack areas) or trees - inside or outside.

HORSE (& GOAT) RULES & SERVICES ON GROUNDS (cont.)

- Please keep your stall area cleaned out and haul manure to designated dump areas. See map.
 - Indoor stalls take to manure staging sites located outside the pavilion.
 - Outdoor stalls collect manure at the end of the pods.
- Water will be available to haul with your own bucket from nearby water faucets.
- Shavings, alfalfa, brome hay, and grain with a variety of equine supplies will be available on grounds.
- Goats are allowed only in the stalling area and the campground as long as others are not bothered and no traffic/driveways blocked. Goats are NOT allowed in the Trailer Lot at any time.

CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES:

- Horses will not need to check-out before leaving the Sandhills Global Event Center.
- Exit out Gate 4 from Campground onto Havelock Ave, enter Gate 2 and use Lot I or Lot K to load up and exit back out Gate 2.
- **Damages/Alterations:** ANY alterations to a rented stall will be charged to you at a minimum \$100 damage fee by NHSRA after NHSFR move-out.

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT:

This agreement is made upon the express condition that the National High School Rodeo Association, Lancaster County Agricultural Society, Inc. d/b/a Sandhills Global Event Center, NHSFR Lincoln, Lancaster County, City of Lincoln, its agents and employees shall be free from all liabilities and claims for damages and/or suits for or by reason of any injury, or death to any person or property of the Lessee, its agents or third parties, from any cause or causes whatsoever while in or upon said premises or any part thereof during the term of this agreement or occasioned by any occupancy or use of said premises or any activity carried on by the Lessee in connection herewith, and the Lessee hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless the National High School Rodeo Association, Lancaster County Agricultural Society, Inc. d/b/a Sandhills Global Event Center, NHSFR Lincoln, Lancaster County, City of Lincoln, its agents and employees from all liabilities, charges, expenses and costs on account of or by reason of any such injuries, deaths; liabilities, claims, suits or losses however occurring or damages growing out of the same. See signs on grounds about Nebraska Equine Liability laws.

WARNING

Under Nebraska Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to sections 25-21,249 to 25-21,253.
