

LAZY E ARENA HOUSE RULES

Welcome to the Lazy E Arena. We are thrilled to be the home of your National Finals and hope to make your experience unforgettable. You can help us with that goal by respecting others and taking caution where necessary. This year we are expecting approximately 1,500 contestants, more than 1,500 horses and 600 golf carts on the property at any given time. Please help us make your National Finals successful by following these simple guidelines:

- Make safety a priority! We anticipate nearly 400 golf carts buzzing around the property, so please be cautious of your speed and be aware of your surroundings.
- Crossing Guards at the Main Entrance (Between Rose & Yellow) and at the Forrest Green/Lime Entrance are provided to safely cross you on public roads. Golf carts are NOT permitted on public roads - Forrest Hills or Post Road.
- The Lazy E Ranch is our neighbor and home to some of the top stallions and broodmares in the country. Do not enter pastures. Please visit the stallions only during scheduled tours.
- We are a pet friendly facility! We do ask that you keep your pet on a leash, clean-up after them, and keep them from causing problems for others.
- We take pride in our first-class footing and hope that you will too. To maintain the arena footing, please do not bring hay or other foreign items onto the arena floor.
- We know it is hot outside, but please do not swim in the reservoir. Fishing is more than welcome!
- The Main Arena will be air-conditioned during the event, please keep doors closed.
- Water is a valuable resource, be cognizant of your usage. We know summer is in full swing, but Pools, Slip-N-Slides, or Sprinklers are NOT allowed. Water Balloons are prohibited.
- Please don't blow a breaker! RV pedestals are made for 1 plug-in ONLY.
- The helipad and the surrounding area and roadway must always remain open- NO PARKING.
- Please pay attention to and follow all official signage at the Lazy E Arena. Towing may occur.
- Please do not post promotional flyers, practice pen schedules or any other signage on the glass doors around the indoor arena.
